EXECUTIVE ORDER 016, 2006

“AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING TASK FORCE LIGTAS NENE”

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution mandates the protection of the rights and promotion of the welfare of women and children, and Local Government Code of 1991 provides the creation of task force for the purpose of ensuring public welfare;

WHEREAS, Resolution No.09, series of 2005, provides for the adoption of RA 9262 known as the Anti-Violence Against Women and their Children and the RA 9208 otherwise known as Anti-Trafficking law.

WHEREAS, flesh trade, exploitation of minors, white slavery and other form of abuses has found its way to and is slow proliferating in this municipality;

WHEREAS, there is the need to take concrete steps in order to quell these activities and fully eradicate exploitation of women and children;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Manuel B. Brillantes, Jr., Municipal Mayor of Monkayo, Compostela Valley, by the virtue of powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and direct the creation of “task Force Ligtas Nene”.

Section 1. ORGANIZATION. There shall be organization of the “Task Force Ligtas Nene” in the Municipality of Monkayo

Section 2: FUNCTIONS

The Task Force shall have the following functions:

1. Coordinate with all the government instrumentalities and non-government agencies concerned in case of existence of child trafficking, whiteslavery and other form of exploitation to women and children;
2. Conduct rescue of women and children who were victims of above-mentioned crimes and oversee the investigation and prosecution of violators thereof;
3. Conduct investigations and monitoring of any reported activities of trafficking and other abuses and exploitation of women and children;
4. Coordinate and submit findings to proper government agency;
5. Provide rehabilitation program and/or coordinate with MSWD for the care of the victims; and;
6. Exercise such power and perform such other functions, as may be described by law or ordinances.

This order shall take effect immediately upon approval.
